Passa Architects was requested in early 2012 to develop a renovation design for an existing 5,500 sq. ft. single storey building that was previously used by a general contracting company complete with a truck bay. The client, a very successful, innovative and exciting employment recruitment company, wanted their new home to be reflective of their successful reputation and exhibit modern trends in office design. The revised interior space incorporated a majority of the existing truck bay and warehouse storage area as renovated office areas and was sub-divided as required to meet the client's space needs. The entire design is inundated with steps, jogs and interior glazing that pique a visitor's curiosity and quickly identify the interior as unique. Varying height bulkheads and corridor walls which move in and out, create alcoves and niches where doorways and interior windows hide from view and make for an interesting corridor compared to typical layouts. Interior skylights and the previously mentioned interior glazing between rooms and the corridors allows for sharing of natural daylight in the interior spaces. The colour scheme offers a sense of warmth in a professionally sensible manner.
